Exam papers are only made available to CAT teachers. If you plan to use the papers for your exams this year, make sure that your school will allow you to schedule the relevant exams either **on** the date indicated (in the table above) or **after** that date – not before.

How to purchase the papers

- Download and complete the entry form.
- Pay for the papers. (Bank details: ABSA, Study Opportunities, AccNo: 4049096187, Branch: 509145.)
- Fax the entry form **together with** the proof of payment to 012 546 5313 or 086 293 2702. (If the bursar or anyone else is responsible for this, please make it clear that the entry form and proof of payment must be faxed **together**.)
- As soon as we receive these **two documents together**, you will be registered to receive the papers and you will receive a confirmation e-mail.
- The papers can be ordered as soon as the entry form is available. *We would really appreciate it if you could order all the different exams you plan to order this year at the same time, and on the same form. However, if it can't be helped, you are welcome to order different papers on different forms.*

How the papers will be distributed

- The question papers and memorandums will be loaded onto the website (www.studyopportunities.co.za) **3-4 days prior to the date of the exam**. You will need to download these papers and memorandums yourself, as they will not be sent to individual e-mail addresses.
- As soon as the papers are uploaded, **passwords for the papers will be made available via SMS (3-4 days prior to the date of the exam)**.
- The passwords for the *memorandums* will be made available on the indicated days of the exams.

How to prepare the papers prior to a practical examination

Once you have received the passwords to extract the files, we suggest that you do the following:

- Read through the paper and make any minor adjustments that you deem necessary. We suggest that you keep these changes to a minimum, as they might affect the balance of the paper in terms of the weightings of the degrees of difficulty.
- Make sure that you have all the data files and that these can be opened on your school's computers.
- Consider adapting and customising the paper by adding your own school name or logo at the top of the first page.
- If there are English and Afrikaans versions of the data files, we suggest that you provide only one version to the learners to avoid confusion.

How the papers may be used

- Exam papers may be written either **on the dates indicated, or on later dates** (at your own risk).
- Teachers may adapt and use the papers as revision exercises, tests or tasks **after** the indicated exam dates.
- Study Opportunities owns the copyright to the exam papers, whether the exam papers are in their original form, or whether they have been adapted. Under no circumstances may any part of the exam papers be sold or otherwise used for commercial purposes.
